1. Christ-like Disciples embrace their Biblical identity.


2. Christ-like Disciples embrace the purpose of our calling.

C. Christ-like disciples are excited to see the Gospel advance (Romans 1:8-17).

1. Christ-like Disciples long to take participate in the advance of the Gospel.

2. Christ-like Disciples are EAGER to share the Gospel with others.

3. Christ-Like Disciples are not ASHAMED of the Gospel.



1. **Read 1 Corinthians 11:28-30 & Ephesians 4:1-3.** Why is our relationship with one another in the body of Christ so important to the Lord? What does a worthy walk demand from us in our treatment of others? How can we grow in gentleness and learn to be long-suffering? How do we protect the unity of the Spirit in our church? What threatens that unity?
2. **Read Mark 1:14-17.** Describe how the gospel message is received? What did the Lord call Simon and Andrew from? What do followers of Jesus do? What did Jesus promise to make them/us?
3. **Read Romans 1:1-7.** What is a presupposition? How do they affect the way we live? How does our understanding of who we are (our identity) impact the way we live?
4. **Read Romans 1:1, 6, 9, 14.** What do we learn about our Biblical identify from these verses? What is the difference between a servant and a slave? Which one are we? What difference should this make in our living?
5. **Read 1 Corinthians 6:19-20.** What does this teach us about our Biblical identify – how we are to think about ourselves? How can we examine our presuppositions concerning our identity?
6. **Read Romans 1:5, 7.** What are we supposed to do as a result of receiving God's grace in salvation? What does the gift of faith produce in the lives of God's children? What does it mean to be saint? Do we live like it is an amazing privilege to be among God's saints?
7. **Read Romans 1:8-12.** What got Paul excited about the church in Rome and what did he long to do? Who is hearing about our faith and being encouraged? What testimony of living by faith have you heard recently that encouraged you? How can we share our growth with others in such a way that it encourages them?
8. **Read Romans 1:14-15.** How do we grow in our excitement to share the gospel with others? What does the Gospel reveal (v. 17) about why should we be excited to share this?
9. **Read Romans 1:16.** Why do we get ashamed of the Gospel? How is the Gospel the power of God? How/why should this free us from the fear of man and enable us to share Jesus fearlessly?
