# Historic Background

- 1. JEROBOAM II CAME TO THE THRONE (793 B.C) AND ISRAEL WAS EXPERIENCING GREAT OPPRESSION FROM SYRIA. THEY WERE EXPERIENCING INTENSE AFFLICTION. JONAH THE PROPHET IS GIVEN A MESSAGE OF HOPE TO THE NATION.
- 2. God allows Jeroboam II to lead Israel to a restored time of security and prosperity.
- 3. Assyria at this time was a nation struggling for its existence

JONAH 1:1–3 Now the word of the Lord came to JONAH THE SON OF AMITTAI, SAYING, 2 "ARISE, GO TO NINEVEH, THAT GREAT CITY, AND CRY OUT AGAINST IT; FOR THEIR WICKEDNESS HAS COME UP BEFORE ME." <sup>3</sup> But Jonah arose to flee to Tarshish from the PRESENCE OF THE LORD. HE WENT DOWN TO JOPPA, AND FOUND A SHIP GOING TO TARSHISH; SO HE PAID THE FARE, AND WENT DOWN INTO IT, TO GO WITH THEM TO TARSHISH FROM THE PRESENCE OF THE LORD.

JONAH 3:1–3 Now the word of the Lord came to JONAH THE SECOND TIME, SAYING, 2 "ARISE, GO TO NINEVEH, THAT GREAT CITY, AND PREACH TO IT THE MESSAGE THAT I TELL YOU." 3 SO JONAH AROSE AND WENT TO NINEVEH, ACCORDING TO THE WORD OF THE LORD. NOW NINEVEH WAS AN EXCEEDINGLY GREAT CITY, A THREE-DAY JOURNEY IN EXTENT.

JONAH 1:5-6 THEN THE MARINERS WERE AFRAID; AND **EVERY MAN CRIED OUT TO HIS GOD, AND THREW THE** CARGO THAT WAS IN THE SHIP INTO THE SEA, TO LIGHTEN THE LOAD. BUT JONAH HAD GONE DOWN INTO THE LOWEST PARTS OF THE SHIP, HAD LAIN DOWN, AND WAS FAST ASLEEP. 6 SO THE CAPTAIN CAME TO HIM, AND SAID TO HIM, "WHAT DO YOU MEAN, SLEEPER? #### 1. GOD IS SOVEREIGN OVER HIS CREATION

- ➤ JONAH 1:14 THEREFORE THEY CRIED OUT TO THE LORD AND SAID, "WE PRAY, O LORD, PLEASE DO NOT LET US PERISH FOR THIS MAN'S LIFE, AND DO NOT CHARGE US WITH INNOCENT BLOOD; FOR YOU, O LORD, HAVE DONE AS IT PLEASED YOU.
- ➤ JONAH 1:17 Now the Lord had prepared a great FISH TO SWALLOW JONAH. AND JONAH WAS IN THE BELLY OF THE FISH THREE DAYS AND THREE NIGHTS.

    - > JONAH 2:10 So THE LORD SPOKE (COMMANDED) TO THE FISH, AND IT VOMITED JONAH ONTO DRY LAND.

#### A. God Is Sovereign – He REIGNS OVER ALL.

- 1. GOD IS SOVEREIGN OVER HIS CREATION
  - > JONAH 4:6–8 AND THE LORD GOD PREPARED A PLANT AND MADE IT COME UP OVER JONAH, THAT IT MIGHT BE SHADE FOR HIS HEAD TO DELIVER HIM FROM HIS MISERY. SO JONAH WAS VERY GRATEFUL FOR THE PLANT. 7 BUT AS MORNING DAWNED THE NEXT DAY GOD PREPARED A WORM, AND IT SO DAMAGED THE PLANT THAT IT WITHERED. 8 AND IT HAPPENED, WHEN THE SUN AROSE, THAT GOD PREPARED A VEHEMENT EAST WIND; AND THE SUN BEAT ON JONAH'S HEAD, SO THAT HE GREW FAINT. THEN HE WISHED DEATH FOR HIMSELF, AND SAID, "IT IS BETTER FOR ME TO DIE THAN TO LIVE.

> JONAH 4:9-11 THEN GOD SAID TO JONAH, "IS IT RIGHT FOR YOU TO BE ANGRY ABOUT THE PLANT?" > Jonah 2:10-3:3 So the Lord spoke to the fish, and it VOMITED JONAH ONTO DRY LAND. 1 NOW THE WORD OF THE LORD CAME TO JONAH THE SECOND TIME, SAYING, 2 "ARISE, GO TO NINEVEH, THAT GREAT CITY, AND PREACH TO IT THE MESSAGE THAT I TELL YOU." 3 SO JONAH AROSE AND WENT TO NINEVEH, ACCORDING TO THE WORD OF THE LORD. NOW NINEVEH WAS AN EXCEEDINGLY GREAT CITY, A THREE-DAY JOURNEY IN EXTENT?

    - ➤ Mark 1:17 Then Jesus said to them, "Follow Me, and I will make you become fishers of men."

  - ACTS 1:8 BUT YOU SHALL RECEIVE POWER WHEN THE HOLY SPIRIT HAS COME UPON YOU; AND YOU SHALL BE WITNESSES TO ME IN JERUSALEM, AND IN ALL JUDEA AND SAMARIA, AND TO THE END OF THE EARTH."

  - HEBREWS 12:9–14 FURTHERMORE, WE HAVE HAD HUMAN FATHERS WHO CORRECTED US, AND WE PAID THEM RESPECT. SHALL WE NOT MUCH MORE READILY BE IN SUBJECTION TO THE FATHER OF SPIRITS AND LIVE? <sup>10</sup> FOR THEY INDEED FOR A FEW DAYS CHASTENED US AS SEEMED BEST TO THEM, BUT HE FOR OUR PROFIT, THAT WE MAY BE PARTAKERS OF HIS HOLINESS.

- 2. God is Sovereign over His Servant and His Mission.
  - ➤ Hebrews 12:11–14 Now no **Chastening** Seems to be JOYFUL FOR THE PRESENT, BUT PAINFUL; NEVERTHELESS, AFTERWARD IT YIELDS THE PEACEABLE FRUIT OF RIGHTEOUSNESS TO THOSE WHO HAVE BEEN TRAINED BY IT. 12 THEREFORE STRENGTHEN THE HANDS WHICH HANG DOWN, AND THE FEEBLE KNEES, <sup>13</sup> AND MAKE STRAIGHT PATHS FOR YOUR FEET, SO THAT WHAT IS LAME MAY NOT BE DISLOCATED, BUT RATHER BE HEALED. 14 PURSUE PEACE WITH ALL PEOPLE, AND HOLINESS, WITHOUT WHICH NO ONE WILL SEE THE LORD.

  - ➤ JONAH 4:1–2 BUT IT DISPLEASED JONAH EXCEEDINGLY, AND HE BECAME ANGRY. <sup>2</sup> SO HE PRAYED TO THE LORD, AND SAID, "AH, LORD, WAS NOT THIS WHAT I SAID WHEN I WAS STILL IN MY COUNTRY? THEREFORE I FLED PREVIOUSLY TO TARSHISH; FOR I KNOW THAT YOU ARE A GRACIOUS AND MERCIFUL GOD, SLOW TO ANGER AND ABUNDANT IN LOVINGKINDNESS, ONE WHO RELENTS FROM DOING HARM

- B. GOD TAKES PLEASURE IN REPENTANCE GOD RESCUES THE REPENTANT.
  - 1. THE MEN ON THE SHIP.
    - > JONAH 1:11-13 THEN THEY SAID TO HIM, "WHAT SHALL WE DO TO YOU THAT THE SEA MAY BE CALM FOR US?"—FOR THE SEA WAS GROWING MORE TEMPESTUOUS. 12 AND HE SAID TO THEM, "PICK ME UP AND THROW ME INTO THE SEA; THEN THE SEA WILL BECOME CALM FOR YOU. FOR I KNOW THAT THIS GREAT TEMPEST IS BECAUSE OF ME." 13 NEVERTHELESS THE MEN ROWED HARD TO RETURN TO LAND, BUT THEY COULD NOT, FOR THE SEA CONTINUED TO GROW MORE TEMPESTUOUS AGAINST THEM

- B. GOD TAKES PLEASURE IN REPENTANCE GOD RESCUES THE REPENTANT.
  - 1. THE MEN ON THE SHIP.
    - AND SAID, "WE PRAY, O LORD, PLEASE DO NOT LET US PERISH FOR THIS MAN'S LIFE, AND DO NOT CHARGE US WITH INNOCENT BLOOD; FOR YOU, O LORD, HAVE DONE AS IT PLEASED YOU." 15 SO THEY PICKED UP JONAH AND THREW HIM INTO THE SEA, AND THE SEA CEASED FROM ITS RAGING.

      16 THEN THE MEN FEARED THE LORD EXCEEDINGLY, AND OFFERED A SACRIFICE TO THE LORD AND TOOK VOWS.

  - 2. JONAH HIMSELF FROM THE BELLY OF THE FISH.
    - DONAH 2:2–4 AND HE SAID: "I CRIED OUT TO THE LORD BECAUSE OF MY AFFLICTION, AND HE ANSWERED ME. "OUT OF THE BELLY OF SHEOL I CRIED, AND YOU HEARD MY VOICE. <sup>3</sup> FOR YOU CAST ME INTO THE DEEP, INTO THE HEART OF THE SEAS, AND THE FLOODS SURROUNDED ME; ALL YOUR BILLOWS AND YOUR WAVES PASSED OVER ME. <sup>4</sup> THEN I SAID, 'I HAVE BEEN CAST OUT OF YOUR SIGHT; YET I WILL LOOK AGAIN TOWARD YOUR HOLY TEMPLE.

- B. God takes pleasure in Repentance God Rescues the Repentant.
  - 2. JONAH HIMSELF FROM THE BELLY OF THE FISH.
    - ➤ JONAH 2:7 "WHEN MY SOUL FAINTED WITHIN ME, REMEMBERED THE LORD; AND MY PRAYER WENT UP TO YOU, INTO YOUR HOLY TEMPLE.

- B. GOD TAKES PLEASURE IN REPENTANCE GOD RESCUES THE REPENTANT.
  - 3. THE PEOPLE OF NINEVEH REPENTED AT JONAH'S MESSAGE.
    - > Jonah 3:3-4 So Jonah arose and went to Nineveh, ACCORDING TO THE WORD OF THE LORD. NOW NINEVEH WAS AN EXCEEDINGLY GREAT CITY, A THREE-DAY JOURNEY IN EXTENT. 4 AND JONAH BEGAN TO ENTER THE CITY ON THE FIRST DAY'S WALK. THEN HE CRIED OUT AND SAID, "YET FORTY DAYS, AND NINEVEH SHALL BE OVERTHROWN! JONAH 3:5 SO THE PEOPLE OF NINEVEH BELIEVED GOD, PROCLAIMED A FAST, AND PUT ON SACKCLOTH, FROM THE GREATEST TO THE LEAST OF THEM

- B. God takes pleasure in Repentance God Rescues the Repentant.
  - 3. THE PEOPLE OF NINEVEH REPENTED AT JONAH'S MESSAGE.
    - ➤ JONAH 3:10 THEN GOD SAW THEIR WORKS, THAT THEY TURNED FROM THEIR EVIL WAY; AND GOD RELENTED FROM THE DISASTER THAT HE HAD SAID HE WOULD BRING UPON THEM, AND HE DID NOT DO IT.

- B. God takes pleasure in Repentance God Rescues the Repentant.
  - 3. THE PEOPLE OF NINEVEH REPENTED AT JONAH'S MESSAGE.
    - ➤ 1 Kings 21:29 "See how Ahab has humbled himself before Me? Because he has humbled himself before Me, I will not bring the calamity in his days. In the days of his son I will bring the calamity on his house."

  - 3. THE PEOPLE OF NINEVEH REPENTED AT JONAH'S MESSAGE.
    - Luke 13:5 I tell you, no; but unless you repent you will all likewise perish.
    - ➤ JOHN 3:16 FOR GOD SO LOVED THE WORLD THAT HE GAVE HIS ONLY BEGOTTEN SON, THAT WHOEVER BELIEVES IN HIM SHOULD NOT PERISH BUT HAVE EVERLASTING LIFE

> Jonah 4:9–11 Then God said to Jonah, "Is IT right for YOU TO BE ANGRY ABOUT THE PLANT?" AND HE SAID, "IT IS RIGHT FOR ME TO BE ANGRY, EVEN TO DEATH!" 10 BUT THE LORD SAID, "YOU HAVE HAD PITY ON THE PLANT FOR WHICH YOU HAVE NOT LABORED, NOR MADE IT GROW, WHICH CAME UP IN A NIGHT AND PERISHED IN A NIGHT. 11 AND SHOULD NOT PITY NINEVEH, THAT GREAT CITY, IN WHICH ARE MORE THAN ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY THOUSAND PERSONS WHO CANNOT DISCERN BETWEEN THEIR RIGHT HAND AND THEIR LEFT-AND MUCH LIVESTOCK.
