❖ Disciple: A devoted follower of Jesus who is **eager to learn God's Word** and **longs to live God's way**.

➤ **ALL of me committed to ALL of Him
for ALL of my life!**

➤ 1 Thessalonians 1:6–7 And **you became followers** of us and **of the Lord**, having received the word in much affliction, with joy of the Holy Spirit,⁷ so that **you became examples to all** in Macedonia and Achaia who believe.

❖ Discipleship: intentionally entering into accountable relationships that are saturated by the Word of God and empowered by the Holy Spirit in order to reproduce Christ-like disciples.

➤ Galatians 1:3–5 Grace to you and peace from God the Father and our Lord Jesus Christ, ⁴ **who gave Himself for our sins**, that He might **deliver us from this present evil age**, according to the will of our God and Father, ⁵ to whom be glory forever and ever. Amen.

➤ 1 Corinthians 11:23–25

²³For **I received from the Lord** that which I also **delivered to you**: that **the Lord Jesus** on the same night in which He was betrayed **took bread**; ²⁴ and when He had **given thanks, He broke it and said**, “Take, eat; this is My body which is broken **for you**; **do this in remembrance of Me.**” ²⁵ In the same manner *He* also took the cup after supper, **saying**, “This cup is the new covenant in My blood. This **do**, as often as **you** drink *it*, **in remembrance of Me.**”

➤ 1 Corinthians 11:26–27

²⁶ For as often as **you** eat this bread and drink this cup, **you proclaim the Lord's death till He comes.** ²⁷ Therefore whoever eats this bread or drinks this cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of the body and blood of the Lord.

➤ 1 Corinthians 11:28–30

²⁸ But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of the bread and drink of the cup. ²⁹ For he who eats and drinks in an unworthy manner eats and drinks judgment to himself, not discerning the Lord's body. ³⁰ For this reason many are weak and sick among you, and many sleep.

➤ Galatians 5:16 I say then: **Walk in the Spirit**, and you shall **not fulfill the lust of the flesh**.

➤ **Pastor's Translation**

Now I keep saying, you must **live continually in submission to the Spirit**, so that you might **never live to satisfy the flesh**.

➤ Galatians 5:22–23 But **the fruit of the Spirit is** love, joy, peace, **longsuffering, kindness, goodness**, faithfulness, ²³ gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law.

➤ Galatians 5:22–23 But **the fruit of the Spirit is** love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, **faithfulness,** ²³ **gentleness, self-control.** Against such there is no law.

B. Living In Submission To The Spirit Derails The Desires Of Our Flesh.

- Galatians 5:24–26 And those who are Christ's have **crucified the flesh with its passions and desires.** ²⁵ If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit. ²⁶ Let us not become conceited, provoking one another, envying one another.

B. Living In Submission To The Spirit Derails The Desires Of Our Flesh.

1. Believers can live in submission to the Spirit because our flesh has been crucified.
 - Galatians 5:24 And those *who are* Christ's have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires.

➤ **Romans 8:13** For if you live according to the flesh you will die; but if **by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body**, you will live.

➤ **Colossians 3:5** Therefore **put to death your members** which are on the earth: fornication, uncleanness, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry

B. Living In Submission To The Spirit Derails The Desires Of Our Flesh.

2. Believers can live in submission to the Spirit because we are spiritually alive.
 - Galatians 5:25 If we **live in the Spirit**, let us also **walk in the Spirit**.

3. Believers living in submission to the Spirit avoid sinful conflicts.

➤ Galatians 5:26 Let us **not become conceited**, provoking one another, envying one another.

3. Believers living in submission to the Spirit avoid sinful conflicts.

- Galatians 5:15 But if you **bite and devour one another**, beware lest you be consumed by one another.
- Galatians 5:14 For all the law is fulfilled in one word, even in this: “**You shall love your neighbor as yourself.**”
